Middle School - Seeking a King

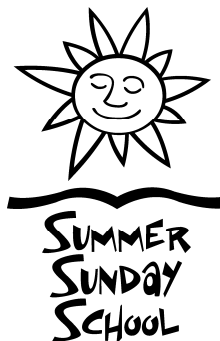
Teacher: Danny Dalton & Richard Zak

Yet Augustine's life could have turned out very differently if not for the grace of God reaching out to save such a wayward sinner. This summer Bryan Toenes will lead a study of both the life and teachings of one of the greatest Christian minds of all time.
