## **The First Scripture Lesson**

The Lord said to Aaron, "You, your sons and your father's family are to bear the responsibility for offenses against the sanctuary, and you and your sons alone are to bear the responsibility for offenses against the priesthood.<sup>2</sup> Bring your fellow Levites from your ancestral tribe to join you and assist you when you and your sons minister before the Tent of the Testimony.<sup>3</sup> They are to be responsible to you and are to perform all the duties of the Tent, but they must not go near the furnishings of the sanctuary or the altar, or both they and you will die.<sup>4</sup> They are to join you and be responsible for the care of the Tent of Meeting—all the work at the Tent—and no one else may come near where you are.<sup>5</sup> "You are to be responsible for the care of the sanctuary and the altar, so that wrath will not fall on the Israelites again.<sup>6</sup> I myself have selected your fellow Levites from among the Israelites as a gift to you, dedicated to the Lord to do the work at the Tent of Meeting.<sup>7</sup> But only you and your sons may serve as priests in connection with everything at the altar and inside the curtain. I am giving you the service of the priesthood as a gift. Anyone else who comes near the sanctuary must be put to death."

## The Second Scripture Lesson

<sup>29</sup> Let two or three prophets speak, and let the others pass judgment. <sup>30</sup> But if a revelation is made to another who is seated, the first one must keep silent. <sup>31</sup> For you can all prophesy one by one, so that all may learn and all may be exhorted; <sup>32</sup> and the spirits of prophets are subject to prophets; <sup>33</sup> for God is not a God of confusion but of peace, as in all the churches of the saints. <sup>34</sup> The women are to keep silent in the churches; for they are not permitted to speak, but are to subject themselves, just as the Law also says. <sup>35</sup> If they desire to learn anything, let them ask their own husbands at home; for it is improper for a woman to speak in church. <sup>36</sup> Was it from you that the word of God first went forth? Or has it come to you only? <sup>37</sup> If anyone thinks he is a prophet or spiritual, let him recognize that the things which I write to you are the Lord's commandment. <sup>38</sup> But if anyone does not recognize this, he is not recognized. <sup>39</sup> Therefore, my brethren, desire earnestly to prophesy, and do not forbid to speak in tongues. <sup>40</sup> But all things must be done properly and in an orderly manner.
