## CCPC Spanish Ministry Preparation

At our International Dinner last Saturday pastor Keen presented the Session's desire to take the next step regarding the formation of a Spanish ministry embedded within Christ Central. (*This presentation was recorded via video. Copies can be accessed ...TBA*) There are two things we are currently asking of each member:

**Prayer Groups:** We would like for all members of this church to get into prayer-groups for the duration of the season of Lent, which begins on February 26 and concludes with Easter on April 12. In these prayer-groups we ask that you meet at least weekly to pray for (1) our church; (2) our witness in this neighborhood; (3) our ESL ministry; (4) our future embedded Spanish ministry; and (5) for the necessary means to establish this ministry, like a Spanish pastor and the financial requirements.

- You can form your own prayer group of 4-8 people. (Please have one person from each prayer group provide our church office a list of its members)
- If you request, we can assign you to a prayer group.
- Each prayer group will determine the times and locations for its meetings for prayer.
- Each prayer group should meet at least six times.

**BeRefreshed Devotional:** We want to precede these prayer-groups by encouraging all of our families, on their own, to go through a 5-Day devotional on generosity called, "be refreshed." This brief devotional will encourage us to think about generosity through the lens of God's Word. We ask that each household work through this devotional the week of February 17-21. Perhaps you can discuss some insights from this devotional in your prayer-group.
